This is a contract for Six (6) hours of behind-the-wheel driving instruction between: Lenny Driving School, LLC, HEREIN referred to as the "School" – AND- "Parent/Guardian"

HEREIN referred to as the "Student"

For the Sum of **\$295.00**, the school will provide six (6) hours of behind the wheel driving instruction to the student. An instructor licensed by the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (NJMVC) will provide the instruction. The vehicle used for instruction will be equipped, registered and insured as required by the NJMVC.

For students 16 years of age, the school will purchase a special learners permit prior to the first lesson. Instruction cannot be conducted without a valid New Jersey permit and successful completion of the NJMVC knowledge and vision tests. Students 17 years of age or older must obtain a permit, knowledge and vision test from NJMVC.

Instruction will be conducted between the hours of 7:00am to 8:00pm, at the time agreed upon by the Student and School. The instruction will be conducted during daylight hours when possible. Instruction will be conducted in two (2) three-hour lessons or three (3) two-hour lessons and no single lesson will exceed (3) hours. Lesson appointment must be mutually agreed upon – date, time and location. The specific skills to be taught are outlined in the "Service Agreement" – a copy of which is provided to both contract parties.

The vehicle used for the instruction is equipped with dual brakes (for student and instructor), anti-lock brakes, automatic transmission, front air bags, and seatbelts for all passengers. The radio, CD or other distracting equipment will NOT be in operation during the instruction. No vehicle occupant will eat, drink or smoke in the vehicle. No vehicle occupant will utilize and electronic equipment – e.g. cell phone, laptop computer, entertainment player – while the vehicle is in operation. The instructor must approve the Student's clothing. **Bare feet and footwear with open toes or heel are NOT ACCEPTABLE.**

Before instruction occurs, the Parents/Guardian or Student must notify the School of any health or medical condition or medication that could impair the Student's ability to operate a motor vehicle. The condition or medication must be clearly defined. The School reserves the right to reschedule any lesson without prior notice should the instructor believe the Student's physical or mental condition is not conducive to be safe, proper vehicle operation.

If the School determines, the Parent/Guardian or Student provides false information upon any School or NJMVC forms or application, the School may reject the Student at any time and prorate charges for services provided as of the date of discovery of the false information. This Contract is no assignable, if any provisions of this Contract are held to be invalid, unenforceable or are modified in writing by the parties hereto – all others provisions shall continue in full force and effect. A modification or waiver of any provisions of this Contract shall be effective only if made in writing and executed with the same formality as this Contract. The failure of either party to insist upon strict performance of a Contract provision shall not be construed as a waiver of any subsequent default. No verbal statement will supersede this Contract.

Lenny Driving School, LLC, reserves the rights to cancel and reschedule any lesson without prior notice due to unsafe driving condition. (Snow, Ice, Heavy Rain, Flooding, National Disaster, State Emergency or any other Hazardous Conditions)

The Parent/Guardian, adult Student or School may cancel this Contract up to seventy-two (72) hours prior to the first lesson for a full refund. Forty-eight (48) hours advance notice is required to cancel or reschedule a lesson. Cancellation must be made through the school email (lennydrivingschool@gmail.com) or phone number (856) 701-3600.

In the event a check comes back due to insufficient funds, a service charge of \$35 will be assessed to the Customer Total Balance.
